



To reach Nubib by road from Windhoek, the easiest way is to drive via Maltahöhe: take the B1 in a southerly direction to Rehoboth (90 km). Continue southwards to Kalkrand (100 km). If you have a pick-up truck or a 4x4 vehicle, you could take the gravel road C21 to Maltahöhe (120 km). However, in case you are driving a sedan vehicle, rather continue on the B1 to Mariental (75 km) and then take the C19 just outside Mariental in a westerly direction (110 km). Once you have reached Maltahöhe, continue with the C19 in a southerly direction (general direction Helmeringhausen) for 19 km and then turn towards the West (general direction Sossusvlei and Solitaire). Continue on the road for 58km until you reach a Y-junction. Here you take the southern branch (D 827) for some 20km. The buildings of Nubib can be seen on your right-hand side. Cross the Tsaris River and you have reached your destination.

For the more adventurous drivers, you could leave Windhoek, traveling South via Rehoboth and proceed on gravel road via Kobos, Klein Aub, Rietog and Büllspoort (B 1, C 24 and D 1206) onto the D 854. When you reach the C 19, turn South in the general direction of Maltahöhe and continue until you reach the D 827. Continue for some 20 km until you reach Nubib.

Alternatively, you can choose the scenic routes via the Gamsberg Pass, the Spreetshoogte Pass or the Remhoogte Pass, all ending at Solitaire. From Solitaire you head South on the C 19 and turn left into the D 827.
